HOW WE SERVE

HCCS has been providing education, assessment, foster care, independent living, and residential services for over 65 years.

All locations serve children and their families through simultaneous treatment models compatible with trauma-informed care and cognitive behavior therapy.

Our staff utilizes Therapeutic Crisis Intervention, trauma-focused CBT (cognitive behavioral therapy) motivational interviewing and the Interpersonal Change Model in group, individual, and family therapy.
