We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Michael J McGivney School. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school **has not** been given one of these labels.

The majority of students that attend our school are already academically behind and are children and adolescents that are housed with the Queen of Angels and St. Vincent Home facilities. Our students are considered at-risk and need support to prepare them with Life Skills.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

Pupils are assigned based on court placement at the Queen of Angels and St. Vincent Home facilities.

We continue to review our school improvement plan yearly. The School Improvement Team meets regularly during the school year. The School Improvement Team is continuously working on data collection and analysis to

improve student achievement. We are making progress in each of the following goals:

Goal 1: All Students at Michael J. McGivney School will receive skills and knowledge to assist them in adulthood and to prepare them to return to the community.

Goal 2: MJM School and St. Vincent Home residential units will experience stronger partnership and unity.

Goal 3: All students at Michael J. McGivney School will experience school success.

Goal 4: All Michael J. McGivney School students will increase in reading comprehension scores on reading assessments.

Goal 5: All Michael J. McGivney School students will increase Operations and Algebraic Thinking skills scores on math assessments.

3. A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL

The Michael J. McGivney School provides education to children and adolescents at the Queen of Angels and St. Vincent Home facilities. Educational services include credit recovery, special education services, elementary, middle and high school on-line and classroom education by highly qualified teachers, under the auspices of the Saginaw ISD.
